Welcome to the 2024-2025 school year! I hope everyone was able to have time to rest and enjoy the summer break. As we inch closer to the first day of school, we have provided some very important information for your review. Eagle Day will be held on Friday, July 19, 2024 beginning at 8:00 am. Below you will find your students' reserved time to visit the campus.

This year, school will begin earlier than last year. The goal of this change is to support a great number of people in our entire school community. Students with siblings in the elementary school will be dismissed based on their younger siblings' dismissal time. While our students are waiting to be dismissed, they will have the opportunity to visit their teachers to receive more support with their academics, including tutoring, test corrections, and small group instruction. Teacher office hours will be held after school Monday - Thursday from 2:40 - 3:10 PM. It is important to make sure your students communicate with their teacher(s) to learn when they are available after school. There will be times where teachers will have other professional obligations. We believe this additional time will provide even more support to your students' success!

ALL Chromebooks will be handed out the first day of school. Fees include the [Eagle Pack](#) fee and the [Life Fund](#).

#3 - School ID Distribution

Pick up your 24/25 School ID. This is required for admittance to the campus.

#4 - Lunch Program

Payment for enrollment in our lunch program is done quarterly and can only be paid on [IC Parent Portal](#).

#5 - Car Lane Assignment

Receive your car lane assignment for student pickup.

#6 - Schedule Q&A

Our Academic Counselor can answer questions about your student's schedule, which will be on Infinite Campus.

#7 - Sports Information

Our Athletic Director will be available to answer any questions regarding sports programs.

#8 - Senior Station

Seniors will receive important information regarding upcoming Senior activities and deadlines, and pay your Senior Fee.

Driving students: Please visit the B3 front desk to apply for a parking permit

Student drivers must register their vehicle with EDUPRIZE High School. In order to register your vehicle, you must bring a copy of a valid driver's license, registration, and vehicle insurance to apply for a parking spot. The cost is \$100 per year.

Walking/Biking students: Please visit the B3 front desk to apply for a walking/riding pass

Students must have an approved walking/riding pass to walk or bike to/from school.

B3 Nurse office: Our school nurse will be available to answer any questions and collect medication.

EAGLE DAY STUDENT FEES: All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Eagle Pack: \$70 is due and payable at Eagle Day or before the first day of school. This is for all 7th-12th Graders and covers all Elective Fees and the student ID.

Life Fund: \$75, if not yet paid, is due and payable at Eagle Day. This offsets Field Trip transportation and entrance costs. Students who do not pay the Life Fund will not be eligible to attend Field Trips.

Senior Fee: \$100 is due and payable at Eagle Day. This covers the Diploma, Diploma Cover, Stole and Cords, Senior Breakfast, and Graduation Expenses. This is for graduating Seniors only. Payments are made to PTN.

Important information for the 2024-2025 School Year

First Day of School is Tuesday, July 23, 2024

- **School starting bell rings at 7:26 am**
- All students must be on time and present the entire day to be considered enrolled at EDUPRIZE.
- Before the starting bell: 7th-12th grade students assemble on the courtyard east of Building 3.
- All students will need an ID to enter the school.
- No cell phones are permitted during school hours. If you need to contact your child during the school day please call the B3 front desk at 480-813-9537 ext 3000.
- **School ends at 2:35 pm M-TH**
- **Friday Early Release is at 12:00 pm**
- First day of school is Block Schedule 'B' Day for 9th-12th graders. This means they attend class periods 2,4,6,8.
